Dear Interested Public:

Enclosed are the separate Records of Decision for the Fourmile Hill Geothermal Project and the Telephone Flat Project. Each Record of Decision (ROD) is a joint Bureau of Land Management and Forest Service decision.

In regards to the Fourmile Hill Project, we are approving the Plan Of Operation with the following stipulations:

- 1) That a public oversight group be established to review the monitoring program for the Project, and
- 2) That there is a five-year moratorium on future geothermal development within the Glass Mountain Known Geothermal Resource Area.

In regards to the Telephone Flat Project, we are denying the Plan of Operation. The rationale for this denial is documented in the ROD for the Telephone Flat Geothermal Project.

We appreciate your interest and involvement in these projects.
