4. To provide the opportunity for individuals to vend.

REQUIREMENTS TO GET A BLM PERMIT:

- Return completed SRP application with an original signature.
- SRP applications must be received by the El Centro Field Office 14 days prior to the 1st vending date.
- Return completed Vendor Supplemental Information Form
 - With an original signature accepting Vendor Stipulations (Appendix A).
 - Provide your Tax Identification Number/Social Security Number.
 - Provide a Seller's Permit number from the California Board of Equalization.
- Return completed Vendor Update/Change Form (Keep extra copies for future changes.)
 - Include each vending location and the associated vending dates.
- Return completed Vehicle License Number Sheet.
- Provide a detailed inventory and price list of products and/or services to be sold.
- Pay appropriate fees for vending days (Minimum of \$80.00).
- Provide a copy of the Certificate of Insurance.
 - Business Liability Insurance (auto insurance will not be accepted.)
- Provide a copy of Imperial County Peddler's permit or a Business License from a city within Imperial County.
- Provide a copy of the Imperial County Environmental Health Services Food permit, if applicable.
- Provide a copy of your driver's license.
